Barbara Blake, Executive Director of Internships & **Op**s, met with Council members to discuss the new ODU Monarch Internship & **Op**-program. She provided an overview of this new initiative, described what the office is trying to achieve and how this newlycreated unit will accomplish some of the goals listed below.

- By 2027 every student will participate in webbasedearning. It is part of the Strategic Plan as well.
- This will be achieved by centralizing the process which is why this unit was created.
- How the university engages employers, so they come to campus while at the same time engage students to participate.

Dr. Blake is meeting with administrators across the campus to discuss how this will work, what will the internships look like, how will they be tracked and ideas on how to centralize so multiple offices are not reaching out to the same employers. The Deans and Dr. Blake discussed the importance of including both large companies and small businesses and the value on internal internships as well. 3. Student Semester Withdrawal Deadlaned Implications for Financial Aid

Robert Wojtowicz, ViceProvost, and Dean of the Graduate Schexcplained the difference between ODU's withdrawal policy and that of EVMS. Our semesters do not align and ODU's policy is that after the add/drop deadline a student may withdraw from any course through the end of theth Week of a regular semester, not including the exam period, or the day before the last day of classes footlader nonstandard semester courseswhile the class withdrawal policy at EVMS is 3 weeks before the end of the semester. Dr. Wojtowicz stated that moving forward a middle path about class withdrawal will have to be negotiated since they are so different. Provost Agho

mentioned that ODU could have different withdrawal rules for graduate versus undergraduate, and they do not need to be the same. Dr. Wojtowicz explained we will have to revisit this discussion again and come to a resolution that works for both sides

4. Graduate Enrollment Information Gathering Session
