

Repeat Coursework Financial Aid Policy

Federal regulations limit the number of times a student may repeat a course and receive financial aid for that course. Ineligible repeated courses will be excluded from counting in the student's enrollment for financial aid purposes.

- A student may receive aid when repeating a course that was previously failed (received a failing or unsatisfactory grade), regardless of the number of times the course was attempted and failed providing you meet the Satisfactory Academic Progress standards.
- A student may receive aid to repeat a previously passed course (grade of 'D' or higher) one additional time.

Example 1

Tyler may receive financial aid when repeating a course an infinite number of times if all previous attempts were failure, as long as those failures are grade courses. The chart below displays her financial aid eligibility.
