Report all Emergencies to (757)693-4000

When reporting an emergency, include as much information as possible:

- Location of emergency
- Nature of the emergency (i.e., in progress or complete)
- Any immediate threats to life
- Need for medical assistance
- Description of persons or vehicles
- Any other information of emergency responders.
- Stay on the phone until released by dispatcher.



ODU Mobile App

Keep track of important information!

- **Faculty and Staff** - Call, email, or add a new name to your contacts. Bookmark frequently used contacts and add them to your favorites.
- **Parking** - See real-time availability of space in parking garages. Reserve a space in advance.
- **Emergency** - Quick access to help for 911, or to find the Campus Exit Scheme and other safety services if you ever need them.
- **Places** - Find places on campus, by hour, in a 3D generation view on the map, or by category.
- **Health & Wellness** - Find the Student Health Center, Health Center, and other ways to stay healthy and well.
- **Transit** - View real-time location and estimated arrival of ODU shuttle buses.
